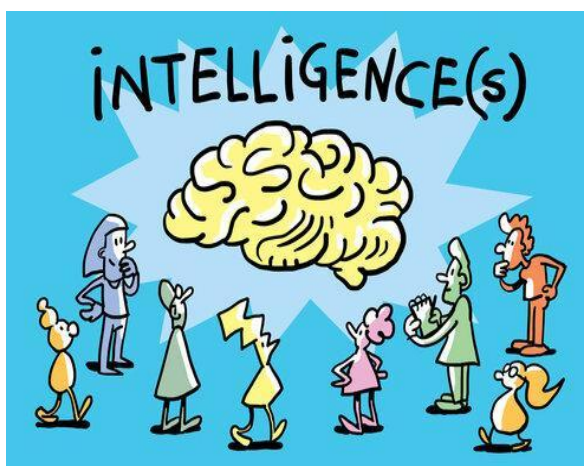

Workshop – Kinetic physics of astrophysical plasmas

We are pleased to announce a **workshop** on the physics of energy dissipation in heliospheric and high-energy astrophysical collisionless plasmas.

The aim is to gather the French community interested in these processes and their associated phenomenology, to exchange ideas on recent advances and to foster new collaborations.

The program will be based on invited talks by experts from these communities, and it will cover three main themes: **turbulence, shocks, and reconnection**. It will leave room for discussion, and it welcomes (a limited number of) contributions from the community. For practical reasons, we will not be able to welcome more than 50 participants.
